



## **Richard Boulton**

Boulton has spent the last 12 years working in a variety of risk and regulatory roles. Starting in 1993, he worked for five years on risk reporting and economic capital at Abbey National. That post was followed by five years at the Financial Services Authority, where he covered credit risk policy, with a particular focus on Basel and EU developments in a new regulatory capital framework. He then spent a year as a consultant for KPMG on credit risk, particularly in the areas of Basel and economic capital issues.
