Speakers:

Gentner F. Drummond (Tulsa) - Following graduation from Oklahoma State as the University's top graduate, Mr. Drummond flew the F-15C fighter jet in two operational Air Force squadrons between 1986 and 1992, serving as a combat mission commander in the Gulf War and earning the Distinguished Flying Cross and three Air Medals. He then attended Georgetown Law while serving U.S. Senator Boren as legislative assistant. Currently he owns or is majority owner of Citizens Bank of Oklahoma, Drummond Communications, LLC (US Cellular's largest national agency), PostOak Lodge and Retreat, an Osage County cattle ranch, and a twelve lawyer firm.

Mr. Drummond's civic involvement includes American Red Cross (former Chairman); Indian Nations Council of Boy Scouts (President-Elect); and Oklahoma State University Foundation (Governor); Citizens Bank of Oklahoma (Director); Patriot Bank (Advisory Director); UMB Bank (Advisory Director); Tulsa Botanic Garden (Patron).
